#1	Sand Scoops	All ages	2 plastic pairs of sand scoops. (come in plastic carrying bag) 1. a Red b. Purple 2. a. Red b. Yellow a. with laminated card showing how the sand scoop works
# 2	Find It! Kids Version	Ages 8 & up Warning contains small items not suitable for young children.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 Find-it game (plastic cylinder with many many little bits of colored plastic inside a see-through plastic tube).</li> <li>• 1 tear-off pad with the Find-it items to ‘find’ inside the tube.</li> <li>• 1 cardboard box for game.</li> </ul>
# 3	Plush Moles	All ages*	2 – 9” dark brown Moles made by Hansa. The * refers to the fact if a toddler or infant came into contact with the plush mole – note the whiskers which could be chewed off by child and potentially harmful. Mole # 1; Mole # 2.
# 4	Hand Trowels	Ages 3 & up*	2 “Happy Giddy Trowels” by Melissa & Doug. (come in plastic carrying bag) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Trowels are part plastic handle and metal trowel digger. * refers to child accidentally hitting themselves or another child with the metal part of the trowel -- it will hurt them. Adult supervision strongly recommended.</li> </ul>
# 5	Sensory Stepping Stones	Ages 2 and up	6 Hexagon shaped flat laminate ‘stones’. Stones are useable either on the floor to step on or passed from child to child. Each stepping stone has a texture for child to feel. With young children it may be easiest to pass from hand to hand vs. foot to foot! Made by Guidecraft. (note: little black knobs can become unglued). a. Blue colored sensory stone b. Blue colored sensory stone c. Red colored sensory stone d. Red colored sensory stone e. Yellow colored sensory stone f. Green colored sensory stone
# 6	Textured Dominoes	3-7 years	28 all wood “touch and match” wood domino pieces by Guidecraft. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Each domino labeled 1 – 28.</li> <li>• One wooden tray to hold all 28 pieces.</li> <li>• One laminated Rule Sheet to Play Game.</li> </ul>
# 7	Magnetic Maze	Ages 3 years & up	1 Wooden Maze Board 12 “ x 15” <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Attached are 2 magnetic wands (one blue, one red).</li> </ul> Maze board is covered with clear see-through plastic laminate; underneath is the maze with tiny red & blue magnet balls that players move around using the attached magnetic wands.
# 8	Cloth Aprons	All Ages*	2 Denim blue cloth aprons. (come in plastic carrying bag). * Apron has head opening for child, and waist strings to tie. a. Apron ; b. Apron

# 9	Headlamp	Ages 6 & up Warning: Not suitable for children under the age of 3 years. Do not mix old & new batteries. Do not use rechargeable batteries.	2 Headlamps made by Schylling. (come in plastic carrying bag) Headlamps have: adjustable strap, adjustable beam, and 2 AA batteries per lamp (4 batteries total). a. Red headlamp b. Blue headlamp c. Laminated product picture card – please keep in bag.
# 10	Goggles	Not specified. Use with caution.	1 Black plastic pair of goggles. Plastic is heavier quality—yet has pieces that could be harmful if broken (caution with use).
# 11	Story Time Felt Board	Not specified.	1 Green felt covered story time board. Opens up like a book. Felt on both sides. May be used for the ‘flannel board’ templates in the themed 2010 Activity Guide. (comes in plastic carrying bag)
# 12	Tunnel	18 months +	1 Light Blue Fabric Tunnel. Tunnel ties up for easy collapsing closure. Note: 2 manufacturer tags have been left on – one Warning label; and the other Ikea barcode and cleaning instructions.
# 13	Contractor’s Sand Play Kits	Ages 2.5 +	2 Play Kits made by Spielstabil. Each kit has same plastic items. a. 2 plastic see-through backpacks with red straps b. 2 pairs of child-size work gloves c. 2 yellow levels d. 2 blue triangle-shape trowels e. 2 red rectangle-shape trowels f. 2 yellow construction helmets
