**TALK** 

\*Depending on the age of the group, the conversation may be more focused on birds rather than being brave\*

WRITE

Rocking Paper Bird Craft (Idea found on Pinterest)

Children will use folded paper plates along with googly eyes, glue, feathers, construction paper, and markers to create their own moving bird.

**PLAY** 

Tightrope walk: children will walk on a string on the floor, imagining they are on a tightrope in the sky
