

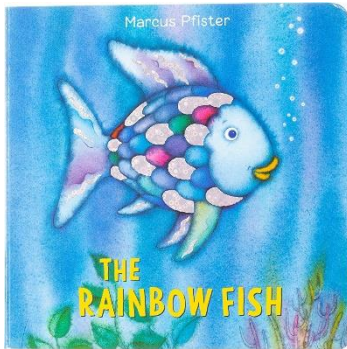

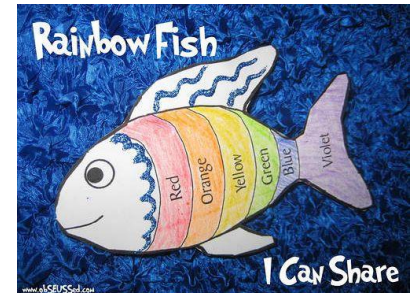
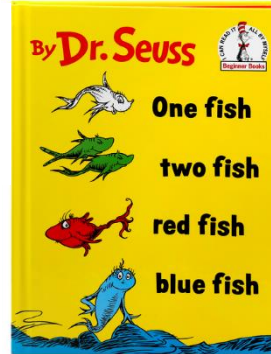

READ



The Rainbow Fish by Marcus Pfister

One fish, two fish, red fish, blue fish by Dr. Seuss



TALK

Depending on the age group, the conversation may be more focused on fish rather than sharing

Do you like fish? Where do fish live? Do you have a fish at home? What would you look like as a fish? Do you like sharing with others? Can sharing be hard sometimes? What can we share with others? How can we ask others to share?

Practicing a rainbow (Found on pinterest)

Using color dotters, markers, or crayons, children can fill in the colors of the rainbow in their specific order.

SING

WRITE

Paper Plate Rainbow Fish (Idea found on Pinterest)

Children will use a paper plate, a googly eye, and tissue paper scales to create their own rainbow fish (including a silver scale).



Providers will be given coloring sheets and color by number sheets to go along with fish and/or sharing theme

PLAY

Sharing Fish Scales: Children will take turns being rainbow fish, with silver scale pins on their shirts. Others will ask rainbow fish for a scale, to which the fish will start to give away their scales, so everyone has at least one scale.
