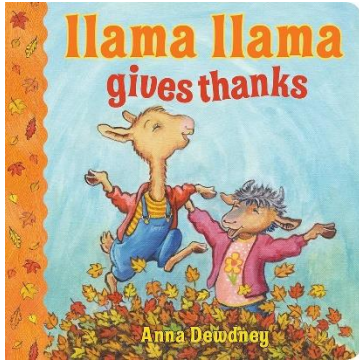

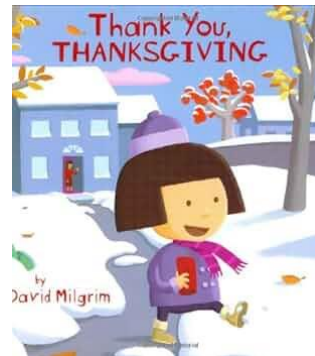

READ

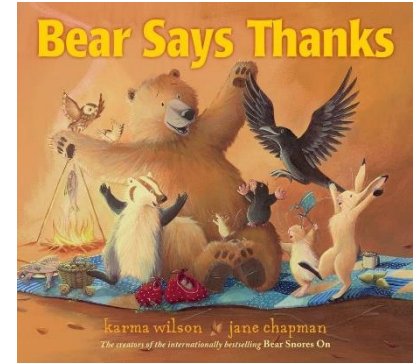
Llama Llama gives thanks by Anna Dewdney

WRITE

Do a Dot Turkey (found on Pinterest)

Using paper plates, paint dotters, construction paper, googly eyes, and a red balloon, children will make their own colorful turkeys.

Providers will be given coloring sheets and color by number sheets to go along with Thanksgiving theme



PLAY

Pluck the Turkey (found on Pinterest)

Using a colander, turkey cutout, feathers, and tongs, children will take turns pulling the feathers out of the turkey. This will practice children’s fine motor skills (by using the tongs), as well as interpersonal skills (waiting and taking turns with others).
