



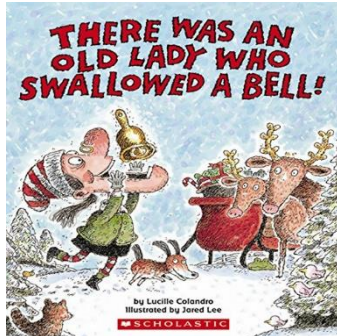

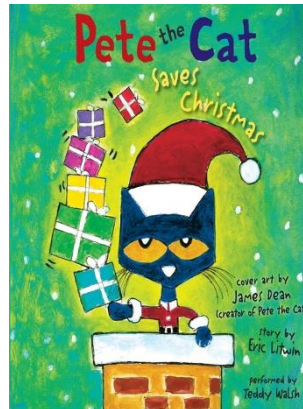

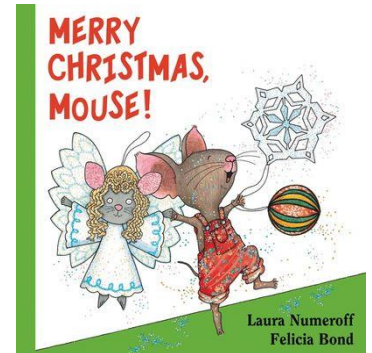

TALK

What month is it? What holidays are celebrated this month? (Mention Kwanzaa, Hanukkah, Chinese New Year) What do you do to celebrate the holidays? What do you like the most about this holiday?

SING

Rudolph the Red-Nose Reindeer, Frosty the Snowman, Jingle Bells, We Wish you a Merry Christmas

Santa mask (found on Pinterest)



WRITE

Using paper plates, construction paper, cotton balls, and a craft stick, children will create their own Santa mask that will show their own eyes.

Providers will be given coloring sheets and color by number sheets to go along with Christmas theme

PLAY

Decorate the Christmas trees (found on Pinterest)

Using an egg carton decorated like a tree, children will practice placing colored pom poms into the matching color spot at the bottom of the carton. This promotes color recognition and fine motor skills.

The other Christmas tree has children pushing q-tip 'lights' through a box to decorate the tree. This promotes fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination.
