

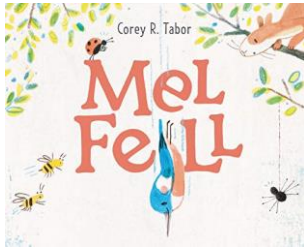

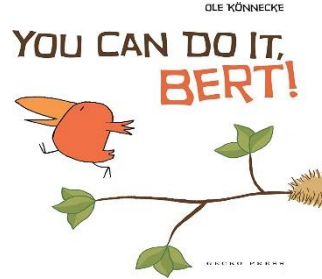
May 2023 – Storytime – Birds & Being Brave

TALK

Depending on the age of the group, the conversation may be more focused on birds rather than being brave

Do you ever get scared? What do you get scared about? Do you think baby birds get scared when they must learn how to fly? What does brave mean? How can we be brave about new things?

Bravery Badges (Found on Pinterest)
Print out bravery badges for the children to color and place in the daycare or in the room to help remind the students that they can be brave since they earned a badge in it.

SING

WRITE

Rocking Paper Bird Craft (Idea found on Pinterest)

Children will use folded paper plates along with googly eyes, glue, feathers, construction paper, and markers to create their own moving bird.

Providers will be given coloring sheets and color by number sheets to go along with birds and/or bravery theme



PLAY

Tightrope walk: children will walk on a string on the floor, imagining they are on a tightrope in the sky
