

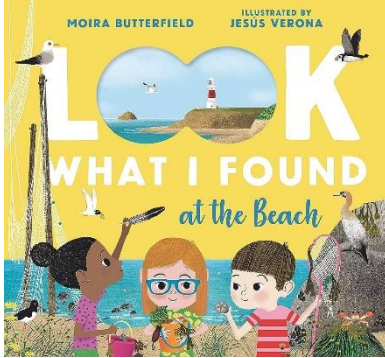

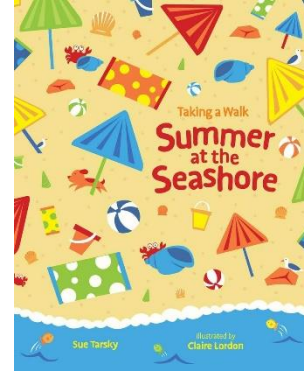


READ

WRITE

Beach Paper Plate (Idea found on Pinterest)

Using a paper plate, popsicle stick, glue, cupcake liner, markers, and some cut out sand toys, children will design their own beach on the paper plate.

Sandcastle Sand Art Activity (for older children)

Older children will have the opportunity to do sandcastle sand art. Using glue bottles, they will place glue down along the template and put some sand on top to create the sandcastle.

Providers will be given coloring sheets and color by number sheets to go along with the beach theme



PLAY

Beach Sensory Bin: Children will take turns digging through a bin containing ground up cheerios (to look like sand) to find seashells hiding in the bin.
