Lancaster Public Library is looking for an Outreach Librarian to join our team. This position is a two year grant funded position, starting in January 2025. If you are a passionate and dedicated individual with a desire to make a difference, we'd like to talk to you.

This position is responsible for building an outreach program that provides equitable access to library resources to all members of the community, while acting in accordance with our values, vision, and mission.

Responsibilities:

- Provide outreach services to existing community partners as opportunities arise.
- Build and maintain relationships with community groups, agencies, and schools within LPL's service area to encourage collaborative programming, increase library usage and visibility, and create greater learning opportunities for children.
- Build an outreach program that offers library services outside the physical building to reach members of the community who do not visit our buildings.
- Understand the needs of patrons of all ages within the community and utilize appropriate resources for programming and outreach activities.
- Support and help to implement library reading initiatives, such as the Summer Reading Program and 1000 Books Before Kindergarten.
- Provide coverage of public service desks throughout the building on an as-needed basis, with responsibilities including but not limited to engaging in excellent customer service, responding to patrons' information needs, readers' advisory, and technology instruction.
- Engage in professional development relevant to library services, with an emphasis on programming and outreach best practices.
- Drive and maintain the library van.

Qualifications:

- Completion of an ALA-accredited master's degree in library and information science
- Minimum 2 years' experience as a professional librarian with outreach or programming responsibilities preferred
- A Valid Driver's License is required
- Clearances are required with relevance to the position
